AACOG Accepting 2005 Regional Awards Nominations

San Antonio, February 8, 2005 – The Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) is now accepting nominations for the 2005 AACOG Regional Awards, to be presented to the winners at a special ceremony on June 22, 2005. These nominations are open to the public. **Current elected officials and public sector employees are ineligible for nomination, unless directly involved in a governmental regional project.**

Categories for nomination are:

- Regional Citizen of the Year
- Corporate Citizen of the Year
- Community Project of the Year
- Governmental Regional Project of the Year

Who is eligible for nomination:

Any person, corporation, community project, or governmental regional project that has contributed to the significant positive advancement of the region and/or communities in the twelve counties of the Alamo Area (Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Medina, and Wilson Counties) is eligible for nomination.

- Please complete one form for each entry. Nomination entries are unlimited. Supporting documentation and letters of support are allowed.
