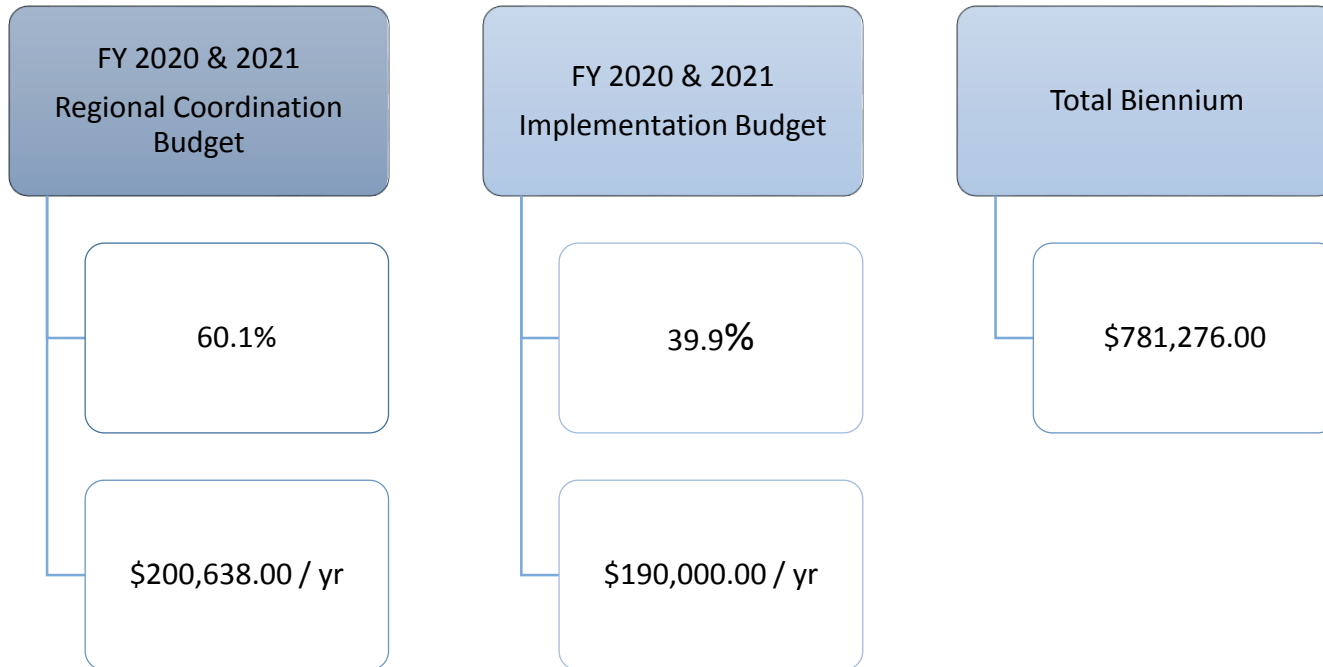

# Priorities Project Goal #3

Strive for a 10 year minimum disposal capacity in the AACOG region through a bi-annual capacity

Promote integrated waste management practices throughout the region's urban and rural area

Maintain the Closed Landfill Inventory

Conduct or update feasibility studies with regard to landfill alternatives



# Priorities Project Goal #4

Acknowledge the generation of the funds dedicated to solid waste management in reviewing the funding project

Evaluate each request for funding on its impact on the region's goal for diversion, waste minimization, cessation of illegal dumping, and proper handling of bulk waste

Promote public-private partnership in developing facilities and programs to enhance the best practices in the region

# Project Priorities- Regional Allocation

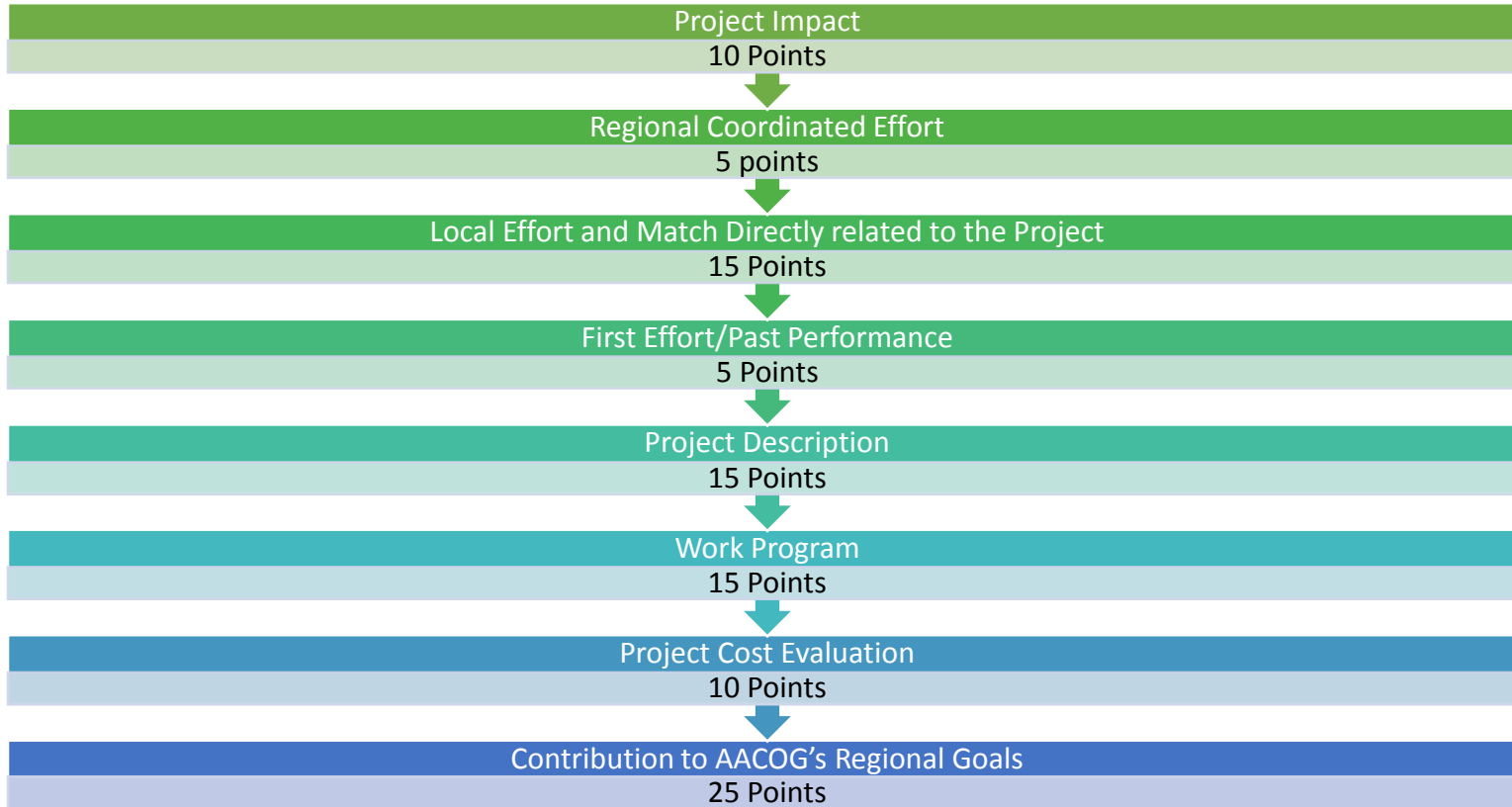
City of San Antonio.....	40%.....	\$76,000.00
Balance of Bexar.....	19%.....	\$36,100.00
Rural Areas.....	25%.....	\$47,500.00
Remaining Funds.....	16%.....	<u>\$30,400.00</u>
(Open to <u>all</u> eligible entities)		\$190,000.00 / year

**\*Note:** Figures for the formula allocation (not percentages) are subject to change if the total available changes. Remaining funds came from downward adjustment of the City of San Antonio's tier. For all funding allotments, only proposals of merit will be funded.

# Private Industry Considerations

AACOG will:

- Send notices to all known providers of solid waste services of the availability of grant funds
- Include a calendar of events for the FY2020-2021 grant program including the review period
- Post a list of grant applications received
- Invite the private sector to the scoring meeting and the AACOG Board of Directors Meeting

# Process for Protested Application is Available

## Private Industry

- Can submit a letter stating how a proposed project interferes with their business
- Must submit letter to AACOG by 4:30 pm, December 30, 2019
- Can attend the scoring meeting to answer any questions about the problem
- Can appeal to TCEQ if no local solution is found
